How to Apply

To be considered for the program, students must submit a completed application and all supporting documents. Internship positions are limited and competitive. Applications are due at least two months prior to the anticipated internship start date.

For consideration for a 2019 summer position, applications and supporting documents are due by March 31, 2019.



Internship Qualifications

- Preference will be given to students enrolled in Texas-based academic institutions.
- Must be a currently enrolled student in good standing at a post-secondary academic institution; a school endorsement letter must accompany the application.
- At least one academic letter of recommendation is required to be submitted with the application.
- Upon selection, interns must pass a security background check.
