

ADDITIONAL IDENTIFIERS:

The decedent weighed 144 lbs. He had black scalp hair (approximately 6 inches in length), brown eyes, a moustache, and a stubble beard. He had an oblique scar at the back of his left arm and a scar on his collar bone. The clothing recovered included: a white long sleeved button down striped dress shirt; a white T-shirt bearing a Texas A&M logo with Snoopy the dog lying over it and a maroon trim; blue jeans; white socks, one sock with blue/yellow stripes and the other sock with red stripes; and brown tennis shoes.
